

TruAssure gives members access to an extensive nationwide dental network.* When TruAssure members visit a network dentist, they can save between 20 to 40 percent on their dental treatment. Network dentists accept TruAssure's allowed fees as payment in full and cannot charge patients the difference between TruAssure's allowed fee and their submitted fee. The chart below is an example of how much you can save when you visit a network dentist.
